Job title: Wildlife Care Technician

Work Location: Lilongwe Wildlife Centre, Lilongwe, and at field sites across Malawi

Division/Department: Wildlife Rescue and Welfare

Job Description:

This full time, 1 year position provides technical support for the rescue, rehabilitation, release, and veterinary activities taking place at the Lilongwe Wildlife Trust. This position reports to the Animal Care and Rehabilitation manager and the Head of Wildlife Rescue and Welfare.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

This is a 1 year staff position with the individual responsible for the following:

- Assisting with rehabilitation activities including feeding animals, cleaning enclosures, making enrichment, recording behavioral observations, or any rehabilitation activity at LWC
- Provide care for wildlife under rehabilitation in protected areas at a field campsite
- Some animals require care exclusively at night. The person in this position will be required to work nights
- Provide instruction for staff and students as required
- Perform administrative tasks to ensure adequate records are kept

Education and/or Work Experience Requirements:

- University degree in a relevant field desired
- Experience working with wildlife and/or caring for domestic animals
- Excellent speaking and writing skills in Chichewa and English
- Driver's license, manual transmission skills preferred
- Bush experience an advantage
